Consent Culture Training Policy

Policy

The Bishop's University Students' Representative Council (SRC) is committed to creating safer environments for all students and community members. As an organization that oversees and manages The Gait, Toast Radio, the Student Success Centre, major events such as Orientation week and Winterfest, as well as all SRC extracurricular groups on campus, we want to ensure that all members, whether elected, hired or volunteer, are properly equipped with the tools needed to help shape a campus culture that is safer for all. This policy will make consent culture training mandatory for all SRC members, on an annual basis.

Scope

This policy applies to:

- All hired staff
- All elected members
- All volunteers for major events such as Orientation Week, Fallfest, Winterfest and Grad Formal
- All SRC Extracurricular group leads

Application

This policy will be applicable to all members listed above as of January 6th, 2022. This policy will be subject to an annual review, every January, by the SRC Executive Team and the Sexual Culture Committee. Failure to complete this training may result in:

- Hired staff and elected members
 - Withhold pay until training completion
- Volunteers
 - Will not be permitted to volunteer
- SRC Extra Leads
 - Will be denied access to SRC resources including but not limited to, funding, bookings, advertising and fundraising opportunities

Objective

To ensure that all members of the SRC are provided with the appropriate knowledge, skills and behaviours that contribute to a safer campus for all.
