



**Title:** Environmental Sustainability Representative (ESR)

**Department:** Students' Representative Council ("BUSRC", or the "SRC")

**Term of office:** May 1, 2024 – April 30, 2025

**Expected Hours:** 5-10 hours per week

**Honorarium:** \$600 (one-half paid at the end of each term)

**Summary:**

As an elected member of the SRC Board of Student Representatives (BSR), the Environmental Sustainability Representative (ESR) is responsible for representing BU students' interests, particularly as it relates to environmental sustainability. The main role is to liaise with students to address and communicate any issues regarding environmental justice and sustainability, while advocating on behalf of students at both SRC and University committees. The ESR will ensure the follow-up of student concerns by conducting research and direct consultations with other students, other student organizations, and/or university administrators.

**Requirements:**

- Must be a full-time or part-time student at Bishop's University, enrolled for the 2024-25 academic year

**Nature of Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Liaise with students to address and communicate issues
- Receive concerns, feedback and/or criticism pertaining to the SRC or the University, in relation to any element of the student experience, and specifically pertaining to environmental sustainability
- Follow-up on student concerns, by conducting research and consultations with other students, other student organizations, university administrators, etc
- Advocate on behalf of students at both SRC and University committee meetings
- Plan and promote opportunities to meet with students for a minimum of two hours per week (SUB Lobby, etc.)
- Attend bi-weekly meetings of the SRC Board of Student Representatives;
- Work closely with relevant SRC extracurricular groups and campus organizations
- Relay findings, recommendations and issues to the Board of Student Representatives, SRC Executive and the students
- Volunteer as necessary for SRC events and operations such as Pet Support Day, Blood Drive, Study Hall
- Sit on various committees, including (but not limited) to the Green Levy Committee



- Submit reports to the BSR on all projects, affairs and operations of their position during their term of office. This report will be due upon the date of the final BSR meeting of each semester and it must follow the final report procedure as set out by the BSR.

**Recommended Skills:**

- Good interpersonal skills
- English language – oral and written
- French communication skills are an asset
- Ability to work in groups and individually
- Self-motivated and organized

**How to apply:**

This is an elected position, chosen during the SRC General Elections, voted on by Bishop's students.

To apply, complete the Nomination Form for the General Elections. All forms must be completed and submitted in the beige SRC drop box found in the SRC Office near the entrance. The box is clearly marked for nomination forms. Nominations received after 12 noon on Thursday March 14 will not be accepted.

Candidates must attend the Mandatory Candidates Meeting on Friday March 15 at 12 noon in McGreer 100.

Voting will be held from 12:01 am on Monday March 25 until 11:59 pm on Tuesday March 26, 2024.
